

## **Ordinance No. 1974-2**

### **An Ordinance establishing rates, charges and rules for the use and service of the water supply system of the Township of Ely, County of Marquette, Michigan.**

The Township of Ely Ordains:

Section 1. There shall be and there is hereby established quarterly rates and charges for the use of and for the service supplied by the Township's Water Supply System based upon the meter reading of the amount of water consumed, as follows:

#### **WATER RATES**

- (1) Residential  
\$8.00 for the first 5,000 gallons  
\$1.00 for each 1,000 gallons or any portion thereof over 5,000 gallons
- (2) Commercial  
\$20.00 for first 10,000 gallons  
\$1.00 for each 1,000 gallons or any portion thereof over 10,000 gallons
- (3) Minimum Monthly Bill  
Residential \$8.00  
Commercial \$20.00
- (4) Hydrant Rental  
The Township shall pay a hydrant rental of Two Thousand Four Hundred Fifty (\$2,450.00) Dollars per annum.

#### **SPECIAL RATES**

For miscellaneous services for which a special rate shall be established such rates shall be fixed by the Township Board.

#### **TURN ON CHARGES**

There will be imposed a charge of \$10.00 whenever the Township is requested to turn on or off water services: Provided, however, whenever the Township is requested to provide turn-on or off service at times other than the regular business hours of the Township there will be imposed an additional charge of time and material plus 10%.

Section 2. Bills for the rates and charges as herein established by the Township shall be sent quarterly. All bills shall be payable on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of the month following the receipt of the bill, and shall be paid at the office of the Treasurer of the Township of Ely. If any charge for the services of the System shall not be paid by the 15<sup>th</sup> day of the month in which it shall become due and payable, a delayed payment charge of 10% of the amount of the bill shall be added thereto and collected therewith. If any bills for the service of the System shall remain unpaid after 60 days following the rendition of the bill thereof, the water supply for the lot, parcel of land, or premise affected shall be cut off and shall not be turned on again except on payment in full of the delinquent charges thereof, in addition to the payment of a charge of \$10.00.

Section 3. It is hereby made the duty of the Township Treasurer to render bills for the service and all other charges in connection therewith and to collect all monies due therefrom.

Section 4. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the conflicting portions thereof are concerned.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be published in full in the Mining Journal, promptly after its adoption, and shall be recorded in the Ordinance Book of the Township and such recording authenticated by the signatures of the Supervisor and the Township Clerk.

Section 6. This Ordinance is hereby determined by the Township Board to be immediately necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the Township and is therefore declared to have immediate effect.
