

Ordinance No. 1979-1, Rate Ordinance

An Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 1974-2 entitled: An Ordinance establishing rates, charges and rules for the use and service of the Water Supply System of the Township of Ely, County of Marquette, Michigan.

The Township of Ely Ordains:

Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 1974-2 be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. There shall be and there is hereby established rates and charges for the use of and for the services supplied by the Township's Water Supply System as follows:

Water Rates

Quarterly water rates for the portion of the Township's Water Supply System know as the Greenwood System are as follows:

- (1) Minimum Monthly Bill:

Residential	\$9.00
Commercial	\$21.00
- (2) Hydrant Rental
The Township shall pay a maximum hydrant rental of \$2,450.00 per annum.

Monthly water rates for the portion of the Township's Water Supply System known as the Diorite System, based on a flat monthly rate, as follows:

- (1) Residential: \$10.00 per month
- (2) Commercial: \$170.00 per month

Special Rates

For miscellaneous services for which a special rate shall be established such rates shall be fixed by the Township Board.

Turn On Charges

Section 1. There will be imposed a charge of \$10.00 whenever the Township is requested to turn on or off water services: provided, however, whenever the Township is requested to provide turn on or off service at times other than the regular business hours of the Township, there will be imposed an additional charge of time and material plus 10%.

Section 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the conflicting portions thereof are concerned.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be published in full in the Mining Journal, a newspaper of general circulation in the Township, promptly after its adoption, and shall be recorded in the Ordinance Book of the Township, and such recording authenticated by the Signatures of the Supervisor and Township Clerk.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby determined by the Township Board to be immediately necessary for the preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the Township and is therefore declared to have immediate effect.
